Resubmissions or Rejected Claims

Claims denied by EDS, are listed on the remittance advice that accompanies your check. If your claim has not appeared on a RA in (6) six RA cycles which is (3) three months, you will need to resubmit the claim. Please attach a copy of the RA to the claims you are resubmitting. This will expedite the process so you are on top of your resubmissions prior to the end of the(1) one year grace period.

Disks received less than 5 days before EDS cut-off will not be screened and submitted by the cut-off. Pre-submission audits are completed in the date order the claims are received. Please plan accordingly.
