The Senior Housing Assistance Fund was established by the Fairfield County Community Foundation and is being administered by SWCAA in twelve towns in southwestern Connecticut .

Interest free loans are available to income eligible seniors for the purpose of securing and remaining in safe, affordable housing. The borrower determines the repayment schedule.

All payments will be made directly to the vendor or landlord.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must...

- Be at least 60 years of age or older
- Have a household income equal to or less than HUD's Section 8 Guidelines (Currently \$40,700 for an individual or \$46,500 per couple)
- Have less than \$5,000 in liquid assets
- Must show a need for the funds
- Must live in Bridgeport, Darien, Easton, Fairfield, Greenwich, Monroe, New Canaan, Stratford, Trumbull, Weston, Westport or Wilton.
