Request Hardship Status

Hardship or Winter Protection coding protects your service until May 1, 2022. Call your electric or gas company to see if you are eligible

UniteCT

Money toward back rent, and light bill. Shut off will not occur during application process. Apply or learn more here or by calling 1-844-864-8328.
