Listed below are the 2021 poverty guidelines published in the Federal Register on February 1, 2021 by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Figures refer to monthly income.

<u>Poverty Level</u>	<u>Single Person</u>	<u>Couple</u>
<i>100% poverty</i>	At or below \$1,073	At or below \$1,452
<i>125% poverty</i>	\$1,074 - \$1,342	\$1,453 - \$1,815
<i>150% poverty</i>	\$1,343 - \$1,610	\$1,816 - \$2,178
<i>175% poverty</i>	\$1,611 - \$1,878	\$2,179 - \$2,540
<i>200% poverty</i>	\$1,879 - \$2,147	\$2,541 - \$2,903
<i>Over 200% poverty</i>	\$2,148 or over	\$2,904 or over
