INTRODUCTION

This guide has been created to assist individual's age 60+ or disabled to identify and explore affordable housing in southwestern Connecticut. Although there are many different types of housing communities serving the elderly/disabled population, this guide is a resource for affordable, congregate, subsidized, supportive, transitional, and veteran housing. It is arranged alphabetically first by town and then by property name.

Eligibility requirements, applications, waiting list opening/closing and rent calculations will vary with each property. Therefore, we strongly recommended that you contact each property to obtain the most current information about that community.

Included in this guide is a definition page which will help to clarify housing terms and programs and will assist you in determining the type of housing most appropriate for your needs.

*Some properties prefer that you contact them by email others prefer that you call them.

DEFINITIONS

Affordable: All communities define affordability
(A) differently. HUD defines affordability generally where an individual pays no more than 30% of income for rent.

Congregate: Type of needs-based housing for individuals
(C) 62+ which provide one communal meal per day, 24-hour security and weekly housekeeping.

Market: Properties where rent is determined by the
(M) probable price a unit will bring in a competitive and open market

Moderate income: Households with income between 81%
- 95% of median income for the area

Section 8: Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
program that provides rent subsidies for income eligible individuals or families. The program consists of:

- project based buildings where all Units are assigned subsidies

or

- Section 8 Voucher Program/Housing Choice Voucher. A person eligible for a Section 8 Voucher receives a federal subsidy that pays a portion of their rent to a private landlord. The recipient of the voucher is responsible to locate a desired apartment where the landlord agrees to participate in the program.

Subsidized: Programs for low income
(S) elderly/disabled/families
where a portion of the occupant's rent is
paid by the government.

Supportive: Assists occupants' transition from
(SP) homelessness to living independently as
soon as possible.

Transitional: Short term housing with supportive services
(T)

Veterans: Occupants must be VA health care eligible
(V) and homeless
