SUBJECT: 2023 Poverty Guidelines

Listed below are the 2023 poverty guidelines released by the Department of Health and Human Services. Figures refer to monthly income.

| Poverty Level | Single Person | <u>Couple</u> |
|-------------------|---------------------|---------------------|
| 100% poverty | At or below \$1,215 | At or below \$1,643 |
| 125% poverty | \$1,216 - \$1,519 | \$1,644 - \$2,054 |
| 150% poverty | \$1,520 - \$1,823 | \$2,055 - \$2,465 |
| 175% poverty | \$1,824 - \$2,126 | \$2,466 - \$2,876 |
| 200% poverty | \$2,127 - \$2,430 | \$2,877 - \$3,287 |
| Over 200% poverty | \$2,431 or over | \$3,288 or over |
